THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (40 M.P.H. SPEED LIMIT)
(A.435 BIRMINGHAM ROAD, ALCESTER)
ORDER, 1987

The Warwickshire County Council, in exercise of their powers under Section 84(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and of all other enabling powers and with the consent of the Secretary of State for Transport under Part II of Schedule 9 to the Act and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order:-

1. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
2. This Order may be cited as "The Warwickshire County Council (40 m.p.h. Speed Limit)(A.435 Birmingham Road, Alcester)Order, 1987" and shall come into operation on the 11th May 1987.

SCHEDULE

That length of the A.435 Birmingham Road, Alcester which extends from a point 194 metres north of its junction with Ragley Mill Lane northwards for a distance of 1,381 metres measured along that length of road.
