THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (50 M.P.H. SPEED LIMIT)  
(A.435 COUGHTON AND SAMBOURNE) ORDER 1988

The Warwickshire County Council, in exercise of their powers under Section 84(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and of all other enabling powers, with the consent of the Secretary of State for Transport under Part II of Schedule 9 to the Act and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order:-

1. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
2. This Order may be cited as "The Warwickshire County Council (50 m.p.h. Speed Limit)(A.435 Coughton and Sambourne) Order, 1988" and shall come into operation on the 18<sup>th</sup> July, 1988

SCHEDULE

That length of the A.435 Birmingham-Evesham Road which extends from a point 1,575 metres north of the centreline of its junction with Ragley Mill Lane, Alcester to the northern side of its junction with the A.448 Studley-Bromsgrove Road, Sambourne, a distance of approximately 3,000 metres.
