THE TRUNK ROAD (A435/A46) (ALCESTER BYPASS) (40 MPH AND DE-RESTRICTION) ORDER 1992

2nd April 1992

Coming into force

8th April 1992

The Secretary of State for Transport in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 82(2), 83(1) and 84(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a), and of all other enabling powers, hereby orders as follows:-

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Trunk Road (A435/A46) (Alcester Bypass) (40 mph and De-restriction) Order 1992 and shall come into force on 8th April 1992.
- 2. In this Order -

"the trunk road" means that part of the A435/A46 Trunk Road known locally as Alcester Bypass, in the District of Stratford-on-Avon in the County of Warwickshire.

- 3. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the length of the trunk road specified in Schedule 1 hereto.
- 4. The lengths of the trunk road specified in Schedule 2 hereto shall cease to be restricted roads for the purposes of section 81 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

SCHEDULE 2

De-restriction

- (i) The A435 trunk road in a south-easterly direction from a point 100 metres north-west of the centre point of its roundabout junction with Evesham Street to and including that roundabout, known locally as Arrow Roundabout, and
- (ii) the A46 trunk road from its south-eastern junction with that roundabout to a point 140 metres north-east of the centre point of Oversley Roundabout, a distance of 590 metres.
