**THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(50 M.P.H. SPEED LIMIT) (A435 COUGHTON AND SAMBOURNE)
(VARIATION NO. 2) ORDER 2012**

The Warwickshire County Council, in exercise of its powers under section 84 of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") (and of all other enabling powers) and, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order: -

1. The Warwickshire County Council (50 m.p.h. Speed Limit) (A435 Coughton and Sambourne) Order, 1988 (as varied) (which said Order as varied is hereinafter referred to as "the Principal Order") is hereby further varied in the manner and to the extent hereinafter provided.
2. In the Principal Order, delete the Schedule and replace with:-

"SCHEDULE

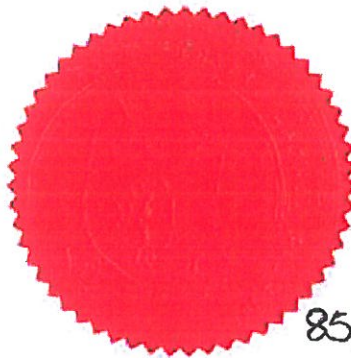
That length of the A435 Birmingham-Evesham Road which extends from a point 683 metres north of the centreline of Coughton Fields Lane, Coughton, to the northern side of its junction with the A448 Studley-Bromsgrove Road, Sambourne (being a total distance of approximately 1459 metres)."

3. This Order may be cited as "The Warwickshire County Council (50 m.p.h. Speed Limit) (A435 Coughton and Sambourne) (Variation No. 2) Order 2012" and shall come into operation on the 12th day of March Two thousand and twelve.
