From a point 37 metres south of its junction with Spernal Lane, northwards for a distance of 138 metres.

2. A448 Bromsgrove Road, Studley

From its junction with the A435 Alcester Road / A435 Birmingham Road, north-westwards for a distance of 42 metres.
