THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (BOROUGH OF NORTH WARWICKSHIRE)
(WAITING RESTRICTIONS AND ON-STREET PARKING PLACES)
(CONSOLIDATION) (VARIATION NO. 6) ORDER 2022

Warwickshire County Council propose to make the above named Variation Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to vary the existing Warwickshire County Council (Borough of North Warwickshire) (Waiting Restrictions and On-Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2017. The variations proposed are administrative variations only to remove references to the 2007 Regulations which are being revoked by the Government on 31 May 2022 and replaced with a new set of 2022 Regulations.
