ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (MALLORY ROAD, BISHOPS TACHBROOK) (30 AND 40 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2022

Warwickshire County Council has made the above named Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which is to impose a 30 mph speed limit on the length of road described in Schedule 1 below, and a 40 mph speed limit on the length of road described in Schedule 2 below. The Order commences on Monday 4 April 2022.

Any enquiries relating to the Order may be made to Phil Mitton, County Highways – Minor Works Team, Warwickshire County Council (telephone number 01926 412142). Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order may within six weeks from the date of the making of the Order apply to the High Court for this purpose.

SCHEDULE 1 (30 mph Speed Limit)

<u>Mallory Road, Bishops Tachbrook</u> From its junction with Holt Avenue, westwards for a distance of 172 metres.

SCHEDULE 2 (40 mph Speed Limit)

Mallory Road, Bishops Tachbrook

From its junction with Banbury Road, eastwards to a point 172 metres west of its junction with Holt Avenue.
