(CIVIL ENFORCEMENT AREA) (WAITING RESTRICTIONS, ON STREET PARKING
PLACES AND RESIDENTS' PARKING) (CONSOLIDATION)
(VARIATION NO. 11 (ZONE L7)) ORDER 2022**

Warwickshire County Council propose to make the above named Order, pursuant to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to vary the existing Warwickshire County Council (District of Warwick) (Civil Enforcement Area) (Waiting Restrictions, On Street Parking Places & Residents' Parking) (Consolidation) Order 2017 (as varied) to extend eligibility for Zone L7 Residents Parking Permits to include:-

- Priory Street (nos. 2-10 inclusive); and
- Tachbrook Road (odd nos. 21-43 inclusive).
