ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

The Warwickshire County Council (Moors Lane, Houlton) (Prohibition of Vehicle Movements) Order 2022

1. BACKGROUND

- 1.1 Prior to the development of Houlton to the east of Hillmorton, Rugby, Moors Lane was a very lightly trafficked route between Lower Street and the A428 Crick Road. Large scale housing development on previously rural land increases the likelihood of traffic using the narrow rural lane as a cut through to the north side of Hillmorton, which has therefore resulted in the proposals below.

2. STATEMENT OF REASONS

2.1 Moors Lane, Houlton – Prohibition of Motor Vehicles

Proposals are for a Prohibition of Motor Vehicles on a section of Moors Lane, for the following reasons:

- (i) To prevent conflict between potentially increased levels of vehicular traffic and pedestrians and/or cyclists, avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road and for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising.
- (ii) for preventing its use by vehicular traffic in a manner which, is unsuitable having regard to the existing character of the road and adjoining properties.

Access would be maintained for emergency vehicles by means of removeable bollards and/or lockable gates.

No accesses to fields and/or off street facilities lie within section of Moors Lane referred to in the proposals.

3.2 Moors Lane, Houlton – Prohibition of Motor Vehicles

- (i) From a point 260 metres north of its junction with A428 Crick Road, north-westwards for a distance of 445 metres.
