## **ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**

## THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (BOROUGH OF RUGBY) (CIVIL ENFORCEMENT AREA) (WAITING RESTRICTIONS, ON STREET PARKING PLACES & RESIDENTS' PARKING) (CONSOLIDATION) (VARIATION J) ORDER 2022

Warwickshire County Council has made the above named Order, pursuant to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to vary the existing Warwickshire County Council (Borough of Rugby) (Civil Enforcement Area) (Waiting Restrictions, On Street Parking Places & Residents' Parking) (Consolidation) Order 2017 (as varied) to introduce the following:-

- (i) a virtual permit system for all types of parking permit;
- (ii) an application process for parking dispensations for vehicles being used to carry out essential works, at cost of £15 per day;
- (iii) an application process for parking bay suspensions at a cost of £60 (plus £15 per parking bay per day in a pay & display area); and
- (iv) administrative variations.

The Order commences on Monday 30 May 2022.

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order may within six weeks from the date of the making of the Order apply to the High Court for this purpose.
