PROPOSED VIRTUAL PERMIT SYSTEM

1. STATEMENT OF REASONS

1.1 Following a period of extensive public consultation and review, Warwickshire County Council is now formally proposing to make the amendments as outlined below to the On-Street Parking and Residents' Parking Order for the Borough of Nuneaton and Bedworth.

1.2 <u>Proposed Virtual Permit System</u>

Parking permits are currently paper based and the Council is proposing is to replace this system with a new virtual permit system. Paper based permitting systems are increasingly rare in the marketplace and the provision of a digital online process has been identified as a move towards greater efficiency.

Proposed system of On-Street Parking Dispensations and Suspensions

It is proposed to introduce a formal process for on-street parking dispensations and bay suspensions with a fee structure as follows:-

- On-street dispensation applications would be open to businesses needing a dispensation to carry out any essential works which require a motor vehicle to be left in a parking place and granted at the Council's discretion at a rate of £15 per day;
- Parking bay suspensions applications would be open to businesses
 requiring a temporary suspension of an on-street parking bay to
 facilitate building operations, road works, furniture removals, special
 events, weddings or funerals, and granted at the Council's discretion at
 a rate of £60 for the application fee plus £15 per parking bay per day.
- 1.3 The above changes will assist with the management of on-street parking and kerbside space, facilitating the passage of traffic, preventing use by unsuitable traffic and helping to preserve the amenities of the area.
