<u>The Warwickshire County Council (District of Warwick) (Civil Enforcement</u> <u>Area) (Waiting Restrictions, On Street Parking Places and Residents Parking)</u> <u>(Consolidation) (Variation J) Order 2022</u>

1. Background

As part of highway works associated with HS2, the junction of Hob Lane, Red Lane and Cromwell Lane was upgraded to a signal controlled junction to provide suitable controlled crossing points for pedestrian / cycle / equestrian access to the new temporary realigned Kenilworth Greenway.

To facilitate the safe operation of the crossing and the junction, double yellow lines have been implemented to prohibit inappropriate parking. The Order seeks to make formal these arrangements as they currently exist on the ground helping to facilitate the free passage of traffic, aid visibility and discourage obstructive parking.

The junction in question lies on the boundary of the county of Warwickshire and the borough of Solihull. Sections of the highway and therefore the associated waiting restrictions at this location are within Solihull and are not included within this Order.

2. Statement of Reasons

Red Lane & Cromwell Lane – Burton Green – No Waiting at any Time

No waiting at any time restrictions are proposed at the above junction to facilitate the passage of traffic and to avoid danger to persons or other traffic using the road and for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising.

Cromwell Lane, Burton Green - No Waiting at any Time

East side, from its junction with Red Lane, northwards for 55 metres

Red Lane, Burton Green – No Waiting at any Time

- (i) North side, from its junction with Cromwell Lane eastwards for 64 metres
- (ii) South side, from its junction with Hob Lane eastwards for 64 metres
