THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (BIRMINGHAM ROAD, ANSLEY)
(30 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2022


The Warwickshire County Council in exercise of its powers under section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act"), and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order: -

1. Save as provided in Article 2 below, no person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour on the length of road described in the Schedule to this Order.
2. The provisions of Article 1 of this Order shall not apply to a vehicle falling within regulation 3(4) of The Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when such a vehicle is used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
3. This Order may be cited as "The Warwickshire County Council (Birmingham Road, Ansley) (30 mph Speed Limit) Order 2022" and shall come into operation on the Twenty-Fifth day of July Two Thousand and Twenty-Two.

Birmingham Road, Ansley



From a point 136.9 metres in a south-easterly direction from the centre line of Ansley Lane, north-westwards for a distance of 100 metres towards Ansley Lane.
