ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(THE RIDGEWAY & BISHOPTON LANE, STRATFORD-UPON-AVON)
(30 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2022

Warwickshire County Council has made the above named Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to impose a 30 mph speed limit on the lengths of road described in the Schedule below. The Order commences on Friday 12 August 2022.

Any enquiries relating to the Order may be made to Mike McDonnell, County Highways Minor Works Team, Warwickshire County Council (telephone number 01926 412536). Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order may within six weeks from the date of the making of the Order apply to the High Court for this purpose.

SCHEDULE
(30 mph Speed Limits)

Bishopton Lane, Stratford upon Avon

From its junction with the roundabout at Timothy's Bridge Road, in a generally south-westerly direction to its junction with The Ridgeway.

The Ridgeway, Stratford upon Avon

From its junctions with the A422 Alcester Road, in a generally north-westerly direction for a distance of 551 metres.
