ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (A452 EUROPA WAY, WARWICK)
(JUNCTION WITH FUSILIERS WAY AND OLYMPUS AVENUE)
(PROHIBITION OF U-TURN MOVEMENTS) ORDER 2022

1. BACKGROUND

- 1.1 Request to implement prohibition of U-turn movements order on A452 Europa Way, Warwick at its junction with Fusiliers Way and Olympus Avenue, has been considered and this has resulted in the proposals below.

2. STATEMENT OF REASONS

- 2.1 Following a stage 3 road safety audit concerns have been highlighted relating to vehicles performing U-turn movements on the A452 Europa Way. As well as identification during the safety audit, this has been corroborated in the form of a number of complaints received by Warwickshire County Council.

Implementation of the Traffic Regulation Order seeks to prevent these movements taking place through the installation of prohibition signage at the junction which will advise highway users of the prohibition and enable legal enforcement of such movements should they occur.

Prohibition of such movements will have the effect of facilitating the passage on the road of all traffic and avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road and prevent the likelihood of any such danger arising.

3. SCHEDULE 1

3.2 A452 Europa Way, Warwick

- i) No U-turns for vehicles travelling in a north easterly direction on the A452 Europa Way onto the south westbound carriageway, as indicated on the plan, and located at the junction of Fusiliers Way and Olympus Avenue.
- ii) No U-turns for vehicles travelling in a south westerly direction on the A452 Europa Way, onto the north eastbound carriageway, as indicated on the plan, and located at the junction of Fusiliers Way and Olympus Avenue.
