(30MPH SPEED LIMIT) (VARIATION NO. 1) ORDER 2022**

Warwickshire County Council has made the above-named Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which imposes a 30mph speed limit on the length of road mentioned in the Schedule 1 below.

Warwickshire County Council has also varied the "The Warwickshire County Council (Various Roads Newbold On Stour) (30mph Speed Limit) Order 2004" under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which imposes a 30mph speed limit on the length of road mentioned in the Schedule 2 below.

The Orders commence on Monday 7<sup>th</sup> November 2022.

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order may within six weeks from the date of the making of the Order apply to the High Court for this purpose.

- (i) From its junction with the A3400, in a north easterly direction for a distance of 167 metres.

**SCHEDULE 2**

**A3400**

- (i) From a point 27 metres north-west of its junction with Crimscote Lane for a distance of 1077 metres, in a south easterly direction.
