**THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (DISTRICT OF WARWICK)
(CIVIL ENFORCEMENT AREA) (WAITING RESTRICTIONS, ON STREET PARKING
PLACES AND RESIDENTS' PARKING) (CONSOLIDATION)
(VARIATION NO. 11 (ZONE L7)) ORDER 2022**

Warwickshire County Council has made the above named Variation Order, pursuant to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which is to vary the existing Warwickshire County Council (District of Warwick) (Civil Enforcement Area) (Waiting Restrictions, On Street Parking Places & Residents' Parking) (Consolidation) Order 2017 (as varied) to extend eligibility for Zone L7 Residents Parking Permits to include:-

- Priory Street (nos. 2-10 inclusive); and
- Tachbrook Road (odd nos. 21-43 inclusive).

The Variation Order commences on Monday 21 November 2022.

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Variation Order or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Variation Order may within six weeks from the date of the making of the Variation Order apply to the High Court for this purpose.
