LOXLEY ROAD, STRATFORD ON AVON WARWICKSHIRE

PROPOSED ROAD HUMP AND BUILD-OUT (Section 90A AND 90G HIGHWAYS ACT 1980)

1. STATEMENT OF REASONS

- 1.1 Warwickshire County Council is proposing to install one Road Hump and one Build-out on the Loxley Road, Stratford on Avon.
- 1.2 The requirement for the combination of the Road Hump and Build-out is to reduce speed for traffic travelling from the existing 50mph part of Loxley Road, as it reaches the 30mph part of Loxley Road.
- 1.3 This was a concern that was raised following a Road Safety Audit.
- 1.4 The installation of these two elements should have the effect of slowing motorists down entering the 30mph area and assist turning traffic at the following new junction(s); preserving visibility; and aiding road safety.
- 1.5 The location of the road hump and build-out are set out in item '2. Schedule' below.

Proposed Speed Cushion (1 No), Loxley Road, Stratford on Avon.

1.65m (width) x 2.5m (length) x 0.075m (height).

(i) Located on Loxley Road, 30m east of its junction with Muntjac Drive.

Proposed Buildout (1 No), Loxley Road, Stratford on Avon.

0.85m (width) x 3m (length) x 0.125m (height).

(i) Located on Loxley Road, 30m east of its junction with Muntjac Drive.
