ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

**THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (COMBE FIELDS ROAD AND PILOT WAY,
NEAR ANSTY)
(40MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2023**

The Warwickshire County Council in exercise of its powers under section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act"), and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order: -

1. Save as provided in Article 2 below, no person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the length of road described in Schedule 1 and Schedule 2 to this Order.
2. The provisions of Article 1 of this Order shall not apply to a vehicle falling within regulation 3(4) of The Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when such a vehicle is used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
3. The provisions of any Order made pursuant to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (or pursuant to any legislation in force prior thereto) which imposes a speed limit on the length of road referred to in Schedule 1 and Schedule 2 below are hereby revoked in respect of that said length of road.
4. This Order may be cited as "The Warwickshire County Council (Combe Fields Road and Pilot Way, Near Ansty) (40mph Speed Limit) Order 2023" and shall come into operation on the day of Two Thousand and Twenty Three.

SCHEDULE 1

1. Combe Fields Road, Near Ansty

From a point 353 metres northwest of the centreline of the junction with Peter Hall Lane to a point 254 metres south of the junction with Peter Hall Lane, a distance of 607 metres.

SCHEDULE 2

1. Pilot Way, Near Ansty

From the centre line of its junction with Combe Fields Road for a distance of 23.5 metres in a south-westerly direction.
