(THE COMMON, HURLEY)
(40 MPH SPEED LIMIT EXTENSION) ORDER 2023

Warwickshire County Council propose to make the above-named Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will revoke reimpose and extend the 40 mph speed limit on the length of roads mentioned in the Schedule below.
