THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(THE COMMON, HURLEY)
(40 MPH SPEED LIMIT EXTENSION) ORDER 2023

The Warwickshire County Council in exercise of its powers under section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act"), and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order: -

1. The Warwickshire County Council (The Common, Hurley) (40mph Speed Limit) Order 2001 is hereby revoked.
2. Save as provided in Article 3 below, no person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the lengths of road described in the Schedule to this Order.
3. The provisions of Article 2 of this Order shall not apply to a vehicle falling within regulation 3(4) of The Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when such a vehicle is used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
4. This Order may be cited as "The Warwickshire County Council (The Common, Hurley (40 mph Speed Limit Extension) Order 2023" and shall come into operation on the day of Two Thousand and Twenty Three.

SCHEDULE

Tamworth Road/Hurley Common

From a point 440 metres north of its junction with Knowle Hill for a distance of 2076 metres.

This also includes small side sections of Heanley Lane & Main Road.
