STATEMENT OF REASONS

As part of Councillor Jenn's delegated budget scheme, it is proposed to introduce a 40mph speed limit on that part of Tamworth Road, Wood End/Hurley Common which is described in the Schedule below.

The aim is to reduce vehicle speeds through this section of Tamworth Road as this is currently a national speed limit (60mph). A reduced speed limit would improve road safety and improve the environment for all road users. The scheme will involve the use of speed limit signage and associated road markings to reinforce the new limit.

SCHEDULE

Wood End/ Hurley Common

PROPOSED 40 MPH SPEED LIMIT EXTENSION

Tamworth Road/Hurley Common – From a point 440 metres North of its junction with Knowle Hill for a distance of 2076 metres. This also includes small side sections of Heanley Lane & Main Road.
