**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**

**THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (DISTRICT OF WARWICK) (PERMITTED PARKING AREA AND SPECIAL PARKING AREA) (WAITING RESTRICTIONS, ON STREET PARKING PLACES AND RESIDENTS' PARKING) (CONSOLIDATION) (VARIATION NO. J) ORDER 2023**

Warwickshire County Council has made the above Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to vary the existing Warwickshire County Council (District of Warwick) (Civil Enforcement Area) (Waiting Restrictions, On-Street Parking Places And Residents' Parking) (Consolidation) Order 2017, the effect of which would be to prohibit and restrict the waiting of vehicles in those lengths of road as described in the Schedules below. The Order commences on 23 January 2023.

Exceptions to any waiting restrictions described in the Schedule below will permit waiting for the purposes of picking up and setting down passengers, loading and unloading goods, for vehicles displaying a disabled person's badge and in connection with the maintenance of the road and the supply of gas, water or electricity.

A copy of the Order, together with a copy of an Order to be varied, plans showing the lengths of road affected and a statement of the Council's reasons for making the Order may be inspected at the Main Reception, Shire Hall, Market Place, Warwick during opening hours and on Warwickshire County Council's website at <https://www.warwickshire.gov.uk/news/20210/warwick-district>

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order may within six weeks from the date of the making of the Order apply to the High Court for this purpose.

**Cromwell Lane, Burton Green – No Waiting at any Time**

East side, from its junction with Red Lane, northwards for 55 metres

**Red Lane, Burton Green – No Waiting at any Time**

- (i) North side, from its junction with Cromwell Lane eastwards for 64 metres
- (ii) South side, from its junction with Hob Lane eastwards for 64 metres
