CAMBRIDGE STREET, RUGBY - PROPOSED ROAD HUMP

Warwickshire County Council proposes, in exercise of its powers under sections 90A of the Highways Act 1980, to install a road hump on Cambridge Street, Rugby, as described in more detail in the schedule below.

PROPOSED ROAD HUMP- Cambridge Street, Rugby

- (1) Located on Cambridge Street; 53 metres north-east of its junction with Clifton Road (outside Cambridge Court 1-6, and Riley Court 9-10).

Road Hump dimension: 8.05m (width) x 4.0m (length) x 0.100m (height).
