PROPOSED ROAD HUMP

(SECTION 90A HIGHWAYS ACT 1980)

1. STATEMENT OF REASONS

- 1.1 Warwickshire County Council is proposing to install a Road Hump on Cambridge Street, Rugby. The location of the Road Hump is outside Cambridge Court 1-6, and Riley Court 9-10, Cambridge Street, Rugby.
- 1.2 The requirement for the Road Hump is to reduce vehicle speeds further on Cambridge Street, which has a 20mph speed limit. Current speeds on this section of Cambridge Street have been found to be well in excess of the 20mph speed limit from recent speed surveys carried out.
- 1.3 This was a concern that was raised by the Local County Councillor and residents of Cambridge Street who have reportedly witnessed vehicles travelling in excess of the speed limit.
- 1.4 The installation of this road hump should have the effect of the slowing of motorists to be within the 20mph speed limit, bringing down speeds and aiding road safety for all road users.
- 1.5 The location of the road hump is set out in the Schedule' below.

2. SCHEDULE

2.1 Proposed Road Hump (No1)

Cambridge Street, Rugby

- (1) Located on Cambridge Street - 53 metres north-east of its junction with Clifton Road (outside Cambridge Court 1-6, and Riley Court 9-10)

Road Hump Dimensions: 8.05m (width) x 4.00m (length) x 0.100m (height).
