**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**

**THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (COTON BRIDGE, COTON ROAD, PARISH OF NETHER WHITACRE) (WEIGHT RESTRICTION) EXPERIMENTAL ORDER 2023**

Warwickshire County Council has made the above-named Experimental Order, pursuant to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which is to impose an 18-tonne maximum gross weight limit restriction on the length of road described in the Schedule below, with an exemption for empty vehicles authorised in writing by the Council to access "The Cedars".

The Experimental Order commences on 10 May 2023 and lasts for a period of up to 18 months.

A copy of the Experimental Order, together with a copy of an Order to be suspended, a plan showing the length of road affected and a statement of the Council's reasons for making the Experimental Order, are available for inspection at the Main Reception, Shire Hall, Market Place, Warwick and online at [www.warwickshire.gov.uk/news/20206/north-warwickshireborough](http://www.warwickshire.gov.uk/news/20206/north-warwickshireborough)

In due course, Warwickshire County Council will be considering whether the provisions of the Experimental Order should be continued in force indefinitely. Any person may object to the making of such a permanent order within a period of six months commencing on 10 May 2023 (or if the Experimental Order is varied or modified pursuant to the 1984 Act, within a period of six months commencing on the day on which the variation or modification came into force). Any objections to or representations in support of a proposal to continue the Experimental Order in force indefinitely, which must be in writing and specify the grounds on which they are made, should be addressed Chris Gildea, Communities Group, Shire Hall, Warwick, CV34 4SX.
