TENLONS ROAD, NUNEATON

Proposed Restriction for Heavy Commercial Vehicles

1. STATEMENT OF REASONS

- 1.1 Warwickshire County Council is proposing a restriction on heavy commercial vehicles over 7.5 Tonnes on Tenlons Road, Nuneaton.
- 1.2 Heavy commercial vehicle means any goods vehicle which has an operating weight exceeding 7.5 Tonnes.
- 1.3 Tenlons Road is a narrow carriageway with a bend which restricts two-way travel when larger vehicles are present. With proposed upgrades to the Heath End Road / Bermuda Road junction making it a more suitable route for manoeuvring larger vehicles, the restriction is being proposed to prevent the use of Tenlons Road as a through route by vehicular traffic of a kind (heavy commercial vehicles) which is unsuitable having regard to the existing character of the road or adjoining properties in the Bermuda area and for preserving or improving the amenities of an area by prohibiting or restricting the use on a road or roads.
- 1.4 Exemptions will apply for heavy commercial vehicles accessing properties on Tenlons Road, with the preferred route positively signed from the Bermuda Road end of Tenlons Road.
- 1.5 The alternative through route for heavy commercial vehicles is via Heath End Road and Bermuda Road.
