THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (THE COMMON, HURLEY) (40 MPH SPEED LIMIT EXTENSION) ORDER 2023

Warwickshire County Council has made the above-named Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will revoke reimpose and extend the 40 mph speed limit on the length of roads mentioned in the Schedule below. The Order commences on 10 July 2023.

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order may within six weeks from the date of the making of the Order apply to the High Court for this purpose.

SCHEDULE

Tamworth Road/Hurley Common – From a point 440 metres North of its junction with Knowle Hill for a distance of 2076 metres. This also includes small side sections of Heanley Lane & Main Road.
