1. BACKGROUND

Throughout the last year Warwickshire County Council have received numerous requests for changes to the parking restrictions throughout the Borough of Rugby. This has resulted in Warwickshire County Council proposing to make a Variation Order. The changes proposed are shown on the plans referred to in the table below and described in more detail in paragraph 2.

2. STATEMENT OF REASONS

2.1 Introduction of Bays for Disabled Badge Holders Only

Throughout the year, Warwickshire County Council have received several requests to install a disabled bay outside of properties where a registered Blue Badge holder resides. After checking with the surrounding properties for any opposition to their introduction, these bays have been installed informally on the below named roads and are proposed to be formalised in order for them to be enforced. This will aid in preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which the road runs by providing a dedicated parking facility for mobility impaired residents.

2.2 Removal of Bays for Disabled Badge Holders Only

Throughout the year, Warwickshire County Council have received several requests to remove a disabled bay outside of properties where it has previously been installed but a registered disabled person no longer resides. The below named roads are proposed to be returned to a shared use Limited Waiting / Resident Permit Holders' bay in line with the adjacent restrictions. This will aid in preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which the road runs by providing additional capacity in the Limited Waiting / Resident Permit Holders area.
