## THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (DISTRICT OF WARWICK) (CIVIL ENFORCEMENT AREA) (WAITING RESTRICTIONS, ON STREET PARKING PLACES AND RESIDENTS' PARKING) (CONSOLIDATION) (MINOR ORDER VARIATION M) ORDER 2023

Warwickshire County Council has made the above named minor order, pursuant to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and The Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Procedure) (England and Wales) Regulations 1996, the effect of which will be to vary the existing Warwickshire County Council (District of Warwick) (Civil Enforcement Area) (Waiting Restrictions, On Street Parking Places & Residents' Parking) (Consolidation) Order 2017 (as previously varied) to provide for the purchase of tickets for on-street parking via a card payment method. The charges for on-street parking and payment methods available are described in more detail in the Schedule below. The minor order commences on Monday 4 September 2023.
