**THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (DISTRICT OF WARWICK)
(CIVIL ENFORCEMENT AREA) (WAITING RESTRICTIONS, ON STREET PARKING
PLACES AND RESIDENTS' PARKING) (CONSOLIDATION)
(MINOR ORDER VARIATION M) ORDER 2023**

The Warwickshire County Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(2), 19, 32, 35, 45, 46, 47, 49, 53 and 124 of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the 1984 Act"), the Traffic Management Act 2004, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. The Warwickshire County Council (District of Warwick) (Civil Enforcement Area) (Waiting Restrictions, On Street Parking Places and Residents' Parking) (Consolidation) Order 2017 (which said Order of 2017 as varied is hereinafter referred to as 'the Principal Order') is hereby further varied in the manner and to the extent hereinafter provided.
2. In Article 2 to the Principal Order:-
 - a. prior to the definition of "charge certificate", insert the following definition:-

"“cashless parking service” means a service which enables a driver to pay the specified charge for parking via phone in the manner as describe on the traffic sign or ticket machine adjacent to the relevant parking place;”
 - b. delete the definition of "pay by phone scheme" entirely;
 - c. replace the definition of "virtual ticket" in its entirety with the following definition:-

"“virtual ticket” means any ticket issued virtually in a non-physical form upon payment of the specified charge for parking by a driver.”
3. In the Principal Order, delete Article 13 entirely and replace with:-
 - “13. (1) Save as provided in Articles 18, 18A and 19, the driver of any vehicle waiting in a parking place in a pay & display area shall pay the specified charge for parking on the leaving of the vehicle in the parking place.
 - (2) The specified charge for parking shall be paid either:-
 - (a) by the insertion in the ticket machine relating to that parking place of a coin or coins of the appropriate denomination making up the full amount of the specified charge for parking for the entire period in which the vehicle is being left in the parking place; or
 - (b) by using a cashless parking service to pay the full amount of the specified charge for parking for the entire period in which the vehicle is to be left in that parking place; or

(c) by making a valid debit or credit card or contactless payment in any form accepted by the ticket machine relating to that parking place for the full amount of the specified charge for parking for the entire period in which the vehicle is to be left in that parking place.

(3) The driver of a vehicle shall place (except where the driver has been issued with a virtual ticket) the ticket referred to in Article 13(2) above in the vehicle in respect of which it was issued and shall ensure that the whole of the front of the ticket is clearly visible from the front of the vehicle during the entire period that the vehicle is waiting in the parking place.

(4) Any person who wilfully avoids or seeks to avoid or assists in avoiding the payment of the specified charge for parking shall be guilty of contravening this Order.

(5) The driver of a vehicle parking that vehicle in a parking place in a pay & display area shall not, after obtaining a ticket pursuant to Article 13(2) above, attempt to purchase a further ticket or virtual ticket for that vehicle in that parking place unless paying to extend the time paid for up to the maximum time allowed for parking in that parking place.”

4. This Order shall come into operation on the Fourth day of September Two thousand and twenty-three and may be cited as “The Warwickshire County Council (District of Warwick) (Civil Enforcement Area) (Waiting Restrictions, On Street Parking Places and Residents’ Parking) (Consolidation) (Minor Order Variation M) Order 2023”.
