THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (GIPSY LANE, NUNEATON) (PROHIBITION OF COMMERCIAL VEHICLES OF OVER 7.5 TONNES) ORDER 2023

Further to Warwickshire County Council's proposals in its Public Notice dated 16 August 2023, proposing to make THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (GIPSY LANE, NUNEATON) (26 TONNE WEIGHT RESTRICTION) ORDER 2023 under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which would have been to:

- impose a 26-tonne maximum gross weight restriction on that length of Gypsy Lane, Nuneaton, which is carried by the bridge known as Wem Brook Bridge, over Wem Brook- from the entry point to Gypsy Lane on the western side of the existing traffic island junction with Marston Lane, to the new traffic island access to the new housing estate, a westerly distance of 488m;
- revoke in its entirety the "The Warwickshire County Council (Gypsy Lane Canal Bridge, Nuneaton) (Weight Restriction) Order 1995" which would remove the existing 7.5-tonne weight restriction over that length of Gypsy/ Gypsy Lane which is carried by the bridge over Coventry Canal;

Warwickshire County Council has abandoned the above proposal of a 26tonne weight limit, and the associated proposed Order, and proposes to make the following Orders under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984:

the effects of which will be:

- (i) to impose an 18-tonne maximum gross weight restriction on that length of Gypsy Lane, Nuneaton, which is carried by the bridge known as Wem Brook Bridge, over Wem Brook- on the length of road described in Schedule 1 below.
- (ii) to prohibit Heavy Commercial Vehicles (over 7.5tonnes on that length of Gypsy Lane, Nuneaton, on the length of road described in Schedule 2 below, except for access. Exemptions will apply.
- (iii) to revoke in its entirety the "The Warwickshire County Council (Gypsy Lane Canal Bridge, Nuneaton) (Weight Restriction) Order 1995" which would remove the existing 7.5-tonne weight restriction over that length of Gypsy/ Gypsy Lane which is carried by the bridge over Coventry Canal.

SCHEDULE 1
18 Tonne Weight Restriction
(Structural Weight Limit)

Gipsy Lane, Nuneaton

- (i) That length of Gipsy Lane, Nuneaton, which is carried by the bridge known as Wem Brook Bridge, over Wem Brook. Location of bridge approximately 18m west of the entry point to Gipsy Lane on the western side of the existing traffic island junction with Marston Lane, the in a westerly direction for a distance of 10 metres.

SCHEDULE 2
(Prohibition of Heavy Commercial Vehicles- over 7.5tonnes)
(Environmental Weight Limit)

(Except for access) (Exemptions will apply)

Gipsy Lane, Nuneaton

- (i) From the entry point to Gipsy Lane on the western side of the existing traffic island junction with Marston Lane, in a westerly direction for a distance of 290 metres
