

B4114 ANSLEY COMMON, NORTH WARWICKSHIRE

Proposed Raised Hump with build-out

1. STATEMENT OF REASONS

- 1.1** Warwickshire County Council is proposing to install a raised hump feature measuring approximately 5.5 metres (length) x 6.2 metres (Width) x 0.75 metres (height) on the B4114 Ansley Common, North Warwickshire adjacent to the Ansley One Stop Premier Shop Ansley Common. Total Road width of 7m consists of – 0.8m wide build out on the shop side of the road, 3.1m running lane widths x 2 making the road width at this point 6.2m total.
- 1.2** The scheme is being put forward by Cllr Margaret Bell on behalf of residents of Ansley Common to improve road safety for all vulnerable road users. The scheme will involve the use of warning signs, road markings as well as a raised table at 75mm in height to give vertical deflection. The raised table will help improve the environment for residents, pedestrians, and cyclists by restricting vehicle speeds and improving road safety. The build-out has been added on one side of the road to reduce the distance people need to cross the road at this location and further improve safety for pedestrians.
- 1.4** The location of the raised table and refuge are set out in schedule 1 and can be referred to in drawings MWT22/133/01 & 02
