THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS, RADFORD SEMELE) (20 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2024

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make the above-named Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to impose a 20mph speed limit on the length of roads mentioned in Schedule 1 below, replacing the existing 30mph speed limit (in place by virtue of a system of Streetlighting).

From its junction with Lewis Road, for its entirety.

9. <u>Lewis Road, Radford Semele</u>

From a point 12 metres south of its junction with the A452 Southam Road, for its entirety.

10. Lythall Close, Radford Semele

From its junction with Lewis Road, for its entirety.

11. Overtons Close, Radford Semele

From its junction with Lewis Road, for its entirety.

12. <u>School Lane, Radford Semele</u>

From a point 7 metres south of its junction with the A452 Southam Road, for its entirety (including the cul-de-sac containing No. 31-51).

13. <u>Semele Close, Radford Semele</u>

From its junction with Hatherell Road, for its entirety.

14. <u>Slade Meadow, Radford Semele</u>

From its junctions with Hamilton Road, for its entirety.
