Proposed Raised Hump

1. STATEMENT OF REASONS

- 1.1** Warwickshire County Council is proposing to install a raised hump feature measuring approximately 5.5 metres (length) x 7.4 metres (Width) x 0.75 metres (height) on Eastlands Road, Rugby opposite House Numbers 66/68 Eastlands Road.
- 1.2** The scheme is being put forward by Cllr Jerry Roodhouse on behalf of residents/parents to improve road safety for all vulnerable road users, especially those crossing Eastlands Road to get to local schools in the area. The scheme will involve a raised table at 75mm in height to give vertical deflection, full width of the road 7.4m, and 5.5m in length. The raised table will help improve the environment for residents, pedestrians, and cyclists by restricting vehicle speeds and improving road safety.
- 1.4** The location of the raised table and refuge are set out in schedule 1 and can be referred to in drawings PTR022/022/01
