

WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCILROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(VARIOUS ROAD, TANWORTH IN ARDEN) (20 M.P.H. SPEED LIMIT)
ORDER 2002.

The Warwickshire County Council, in exercise of its powers under Section 84(1)(a) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and of all other enabling powers and, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

1. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour on the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
2. The Warwickshire County Council (various Roads, Tanworth in Arden) (Restricted Roads) Order 1991 is hereby Revoked. (197)
3. This Order may be cited as "The Warwickshire County Council (Various Roads Tanworth in Arden) (20 m.p.h. speed limit) Order 2002" and shall come into operation on the 4th November 2002.

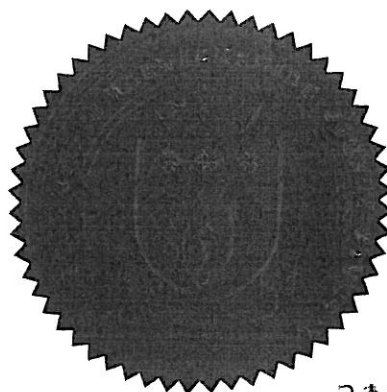
ScheduleTANWORTH IN ARDEN
20 M.P.H. SPEED LIMIT

1. Bates Lane
From its junction with The Green and Vicarage Hill south-westwards for 360 metres and then southwards for 20 metres.
2. Bellfield
The whole length.
3. Butts Lane
From its junction with Doctor's Hill south-eastwards for 220 metres.
4. Doctor's Hill
The whole length.
5. The Green
The whole length.
6. Vicarage Hill
From its junction with Bates Lane in a generally north-westerly direction for 270 metres.
7. Well Lane
From its junction with The Green south-eastwards for 90 metres.
