## ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

## THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (GIPSY LANE, NUNEATON)

 (PROHIBITION OF COMMERCIAL VEHICLES OF OVER 7.5 TONNES) ORDER 2024The Warwickshire County Council, in exercise of its powers under sections 1,2 and 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. In this Order:-
"heavy commercial vehicle" has the same meaning as in Section 138 of the Act.
"Plan" shall mean the plan attached hereto and numbered PTRO23 00502.
2. Save as provided in Article 3 of this Order, no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause any heavy commercial vehicle to proceed on the length of Gipsy Lane, Nuneaton, shown coloured pink on the attached Plan.
3. Nothing in Article 2 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause a heavy commercial vehicle to proceed in the length of road referred to therein if the vehicle is being used:-
(1) for or in connection with the conveyance of goods to or from any premises situated on, or adjacent to, that length of road/any of those lengths of road;
(2) for the purposes of agriculture on any land adjacent to that length of road/any of those lengths of road or for or in connection with conveyance or haulage of timber felled upon such land;
(3) in connection with the carrying out on, or on premises situated on or adjacent to, that length of road/any of those lengths of road of any of the following operations, namely:-
(i) building, industrial or demolition operations
(ii) the removal of obstructions to traffic
(iii) maintenance, improvement, repair or reconstruction work, and
(iv) the laying, erection, alteration, or repair in, or in land adjacent to, the road/any of those lengths of road, of any sewer, or any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of water, gas or electricity, or any telecommunications apparatus as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984;
(4) for fire brigade, police or ambulance purposes;
(5) to proceed to or from any premises which are situated on, or adjacent to, that length of road/any of those lengths of road and at which the vehicle is to be, or has been, garaged, serviced or repaired;
(6) in the service of a local authority or a water undertaker or sewerage undertaker or the Environment Agency in pursuance of statutory powers or duties which are being undertaken on that road/any of those lengths of road or on adjacent land or premises;
(7) for or in connection with the conveyance of goods for sale from the vehicle on that road/any of those lengths of road; or
(8) in connection with a circus, fair, market or similar event to be held on, or in the vicinity of any of, those lengths of road.
4. The Council is satisfied that for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which the road specified in the Schedule to this Order runs by restricting the use on that road by heavy commercial vehicles, it is requisite that section 3(1) of the Act should not apply to this Order.
5. This Order shall come into operation on the $24^{\text {th }}$ day of June Two thousand and twenty-four and may be cited as "The Warwickshire County Council (Gipsy Lane, Nuneaton) (Prohibition of Commercial Vehicles of over 7.5 Tonnes) Order 2024".
