THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (GIPSY LANE, NUNEATON)
(18 TONNE WEIGHT RESTRICTION) ORDER 2024

The Warwickshire County Council in exercise of its powers under sections 1 and 2 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act"), and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. In this Order:-

“Maximum Gross Weight” shall have the same meaning as in Schedule 1 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016; and

2. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle, the Maximum Gross Weight of which exceeds 18 tonnes, to proceed in that length of Gipsy Lane, Nuneaton, which is carried by the bridge known as Wem Brook Bridge over Wem Brook, Nuneaton.
3. “The Warwickshire County Council (Gipsy Lane Canal Bridge, Nuneaton) (Weight Restriction) Order 1995” is revoked in its entirety.
4. This Order shall come into operation on the 24th day of June Two thousand and twenty-four and may be cited as "The Warwickshire County Council (Gipsy Lane, Nuneaton) (18 Tonne Weight Restriction) Order 2024”.


