ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS, SOUTHAM)
(20 MPH SPEED LIMIT) (VARIATION NO. 1) ORDER 2024

Warwickshire County Council has made the above-named Order, pursuant to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which is to reduce the 20 mph speed limit on the length of road described in the Schedule below. The length of road described in the Schedule below would instead be subject to a 30 mph speed limit by virtue of street lighting.

The Order commences on Monday 1 July 2024.

Any enquiries relating to the Order may be made to Mike McDonnell, County Highways Minor Works Team (telephone number 01926 412536). Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order may within six weeks from the date of the making of the Order apply to the High Court for this purpose.

SCHEDULE

(Length of road to become 30mph by virtue of street lighting)

Coventry Street, Southam

From a point adjacent to property number 11 Coventry Street, southwards for a distance of 60 metres.
