**THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (A429 SMITH STREET,
A429 ST JOHNS AND D4129 ST JOHNS (SERVICE ROAD), WARWICK)
(NO RIGHT TURNS) ORDER 2024**

1. BACKGROUND

- 1.1 As part of the wider Warwick Town Centre proposals, Warwickshire County Council's Transport Planning team have developed a scheme to improve St Johns junction to ease vehicle flows and improve facilities for pedestrians and cyclists.

2. STATEMENT OF REASONS

Implementation of the Traffic Regulation Order seeks to prevent right turn movements through the installation of appropriate prohibition signage/road markings at the relevant junctions which will advise highway users of the prohibition and enable legal enforcement of such movements should they occur.

Prohibition of such movements will have the effect of facilitating the passage on the road of all traffic and avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road and prevent the likelihood of any such danger arising.
