**THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (ST JOHNS AND SMITH STREET,
WARWICK) (PROHIBITION OF RIGHT TURNS) ORDER 2024**

The Warwickshire County Council in exercise of its powers under sections 1 and 2 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as “the Act”), and of all other powers them enabling in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. No person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause any vehicle to make a right hand turn in the lengths of road described in the Schedule below.
2. The Order shall come into operation on the _____ day of _____ Two thousand and twenty-four and may be cited as ‘The Warwickshire County Council (St Johns and Smith Street, Warwick) (Prohibition of Right Turns) Order 2024.

THE SCHEDULE
(Prohibition of right turns)

(1) A429 Smith Street, Warwick

From the A429 Smith Street (at its junction St Nicholas Church Street / A429 St Johns), onto the A429 St Nicholas Church Street.

(2) A429 St Johns, Warwick

From the A429 St Johns, onto the D4129 St Johns (service road).

(3) D4128 St Johns Service Road, Warwick

From the D4128 St Johns (service road), onto the A429 St Johns
