THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (D4090 CROSS STREET AND D4129 ST JOHNS, WARWICK) (ONE WAY TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

1. BACKGROUND

1.1 As part of the wider Warwick Town Centre proposals, Warwickshire County Council's Transport Planning team have developed a scheme to improve St Johns junction to ease vehicle flows and improve facilities for pedestrians and cyclists.

2. STATEMENT OF REASONS

Implementation of the Traffic Regulation Order seeks to introduce one way traffic movement through the installation of appropriate prohibition signage/road markings at the relevant junctions which will advise highway users of the prohibition and enable legal enforcement of such movements should they occur.

Prohibition of certain movements will have the effect of facilitating the passage on the road of all traffic and avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road and prevent the likelihood of any such danger arising.

3.1 Plan Ref. 9.2-A429-068-031 to be included in the Schedule and attached to the Order.

D4090 Cross Street, Warwick

(i) From its junction with A429 Smith Street, in a north westerly direction for a distance of 29m - one way traffic flow in a north westerly direction only

D4129 St Johns (service road), Warwick

(i) From its junction with D4128 The Paddocks, in a generally south westerly direction for a distance of 83m - one way traffic flow in a generally south westerly direction only

4. Existing Order to be revoked.

4.1 No orders located. Cross Street may have 2no. no turn orders in place looking at on street signage but this may also be incorrect.
