(CIVIL ENFORCEMENT AREA) (WAITING RESTRICTIONS, ON STREET PARKING PLACES &
RESIDENTS' PARKING) (CONSOLIDATION) (VARIATION NO.9) ORDER 2024

Warwickshire County Council propose to make the above-named Order, pursuant to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to vary the existing Warwickshire County Council (District of Stratford on Avon) (Civil Enforcement Area) (Waiting Restrictions, On Street Parking Places & Residents' Parking) (Consolidation) Order 2017 (as varied) as described in the Schedule below.

John Street, Stratford-upon-Avon

East side, from 8 metres north of its junction with Guild Street, northwards for 69 metres

Mulberry Street, Stratford-upon-Avon

South side, from 10 metres east of its junction with Shakespeare Street, eastwards for 20 metres
South side, from 83 metres east of its junction with Shakespeare Street, eastwards for 16 metres

Payton Street, Stratford-upon-Avon

North side, from 14 metres east of its junction with Lock Close, eastwards for 168 metres

Shakespeare Street, Stratford-upon-Avon

West side, from 36 metres north of its junction with Guild Street, northwards for 10 metres
West side, from 71 metres north of its junction with Guild Street, northwards for 10 metres

Tyler Street, Stratford-upon-Avon

West side, from 3 metres north of its junction with Guild Street, northwards for 57 metres
East side, from 3 metres north of its junction with Guild Street, northwards for 74 metres

No Waiting At Any Time

Payton Street, Stratford-upon-Avon

North side, from its junction with Lock Close, eastwards for 14 metres

Additional Eligibility for Zone S2 Residents' Parking Permits (and the removal of Zone S4)

John Street – all residential properties

Payton Street – all residential properties

Tyler Street – all residential properties

Samaritans – to be eligible to apply for up to 4 no. S2 permits for use between 6pm-8am

Additional Eligibility for Zone S3 Residents' Parking Permits

St Gregory's Road – all residential properties
