**THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (D2204 CHANTRY HEATH LANE /
STONELEIGH ROAD, BAGINTON)
(50 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2024**

Warwickshire County Council propose to make the above named Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to impose a 50 mph speed limit on the length of road mentioned in the Schedule below.
