ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (C43 GALLOWS HILL, WARWICK)
(PROHIBITION OF U-TURN MOVEMENTS) ORDER 2024

1. BACKGROUND

- 1.1 Request to implement prohibition of U-turn movements order on C43 Gallows Hill, Warwick at its junction with Fusiliers Way and William Freeman Way, has been considered and this has resulted in the proposals below.

2. STATEMENT OF REASONS

- 2.1 Implementation of the Traffic Regulation Order seeks to prevent U-turn movements taking place through the installation of prohibition signage at the junction which will advise highway users of the prohibition and enable legal enforcement of such movements should they occur.

Prohibition of such movements will have the effect of facilitating the passage on the road of all traffic and avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road and prevent the likelihood of any such danger arising.

3. SCHEDULE 1

Drawing PTRO23 032 to be included in Schedule 1 and attached to the Order.

C43 Gallows Hill, Warwick (Prohibition Of U-Turn Movements)

- (i) No U-turns for vehicles travelling in a north westerly direction on the C43 Gallows Hill onto the south eastbound carriageway, as shown coloured grey on the plan, and located at the junction of Fusiliers Way and William Freeman Way.
- (ii) No U-turns for vehicles travelling in a south easterly direction on the C43 Gallows Hill, onto the north westbound carriageway, as shown coloured grey on the plan and located at the junction of Fusiliers Way and William Freeman Way.
