# THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (C43 GALLOWS HILL, WARWICK) (PROHIBITION OF U-TURN MOVEMENTS) ORDER 2024

Warwickshire County Council has made the above named Order under the road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit U-turn movements as described in the Schedule below. The Order commences on 2 September 2024.

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order may within six weeks from the date of the making of the Order apply to the High Court for this purpose.

#### **SCHEDULE**

## C43 Gallows Hill, Warwick (Prohibition Of U-Turn Movements)

- (i) No U-turns for vehicles travelling in a north westerly direction on the C43 Gallows Hill onto the south eastbound carriageway, as shown coloured grey on the plan, and located at the junction of Fusiliers Way and William Freeman Way.
- (ii) No U-turns for vehicles travelling in a south easterly direction on the C43 Gallows Hill, onto the north westbound carriageway, as shown coloured grey on the plan, and located at the junction of Fusiliers Way and William Freeman Way.
