ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(VARIOUS STREETS, STRATFORD-UPON-AVON TOWN CENTRE)
(20 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2024

Warwickshire County Council has made the above-named Order, pursuant to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to introduce a 20 mph speed limit on the lengths of road within Stratford-upon-Avon as described in the Schedule below. The Order commences on 5 September 2024.

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order may within six weeks from the date of the making of the Order apply to the High Court for this purpose.

Avon Meadow Close, Bridge Street, Broad Street, Broad Walk, Bull Street, Chapel Lane, Chapel Street, Cherry Street, Chestnut Walk, Church Street, College Lane, College Mews, College Street, Ely Street, Greenhill Street, Henley Street, High Street, Holtom Street, Mansell Street, Meer Street, Mill Lane, Narrow Lane, New Broad Street, New Street, Old Town, Rother Street, Ryland Street, Saffron Meadow, Saffron Walk, Sanctus Drive, Sanctus Street, Scholars Lane, Sheep Street, Southern Lane, Trinity Street, Union Street, Waterside, West Street, Windsor Street and Wood Street.
