**THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (KNIGHTS LANE, TIDDINGTON)
(30 & 40 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2024**

**THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (LOXLEY ROAD/STRATFORD ROAD, LOXLEY
LANE, KNIGHTS LANE, PIMLICO LANE, CHURCH LANE ALVESTON, KISSING TREE LANE
ALVESTON, ALVESTON HILL, HUNSCOTE LANE AND CHARLECOTE ROAD) (50 MPH
SPEED LIMIT) (ORDER 2012) (VARIATION NO. 2) ORDER 2024**

Warwickshire County Council has made the above-named Orders, pursuant to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to replace the existing 50 mph speed limit with 40 mph and 30 mph speed limits on the lengths of road described in Schedules 1 and 2 below. The Orders commence on 4 September 2024.

A copy of the Orders, together with a copy of the Order being varied, a plan showing the length of road affected and a statement of the Council's reasons for making the Orders may be inspected at the Main Reception, Shire Hall, Market Place, Warwick during usual opening hours, or online at <https://www.warwickshire.gov.uk/news/20209/stratford-avon-district>

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Orders or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Orders may within six weeks from the date of the making of the Orders apply to the High Court for this purpose.

SCHEDULE 1
(40mph Speed Limit)

Knights Lane, Tiddington

From its junction with Loxley Road, northwards to a point 17 metres south of its centreline junction with Townsend Road.

SCHEDULE 2
(30 mph Speed Limit)

Knights Lane, Tiddington

From the centreline of its junction with Townsend Road, southwards for a distance of 17 metres (to the first street lighting column where the 30 mph speed limit then continues by virtue of street lighting).
