ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (DISTRICT OF WARWICK) (CIVIL ENFORCEMENT AREA) (WAITING RESTRICTIONS, ON STREET PARKING PLACES AND RESIDENTS' PARKING) (CONSOLIDATION) (VARIATION O) ORDER 2024

Warwickshire County Council has made the above named Order, pursuant to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which is to vary the existing Warwickshire County Council (District of Warwick) (Civil Enforcement Area) (Waiting Restrictions, On-Street Parking Places And Residents' Parking) (Consolidation) Order 2017, as described (by approximate measurements) in the Schedule below. The Order commences on 7 October 2024.

Exceptions to any waiting restrictions described in the Schedule below permit waiting for the purposes of picking up and setting down passengers, loading and unloading goods, for vehicles displaying a disabled person's badge and in connection with the maintenance of the road and the supply of gas, water or electricity.

A copy of the Order, together with a copy of an Order being varied, plans showing the lengths of road affected and a statement of the Council's reasons for making the Order are available to view at Shire Hall, Market Place, Warwick, and online on the Council's website at https://www.warwickshire.gov.uk/news/20210/warwick-district

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order may within six weeks from the date of the making of the Order apply to the High Court for this purpose.

SCHEDULE No Waiting At Any Time

B4099 Warwick Place / Warwick Street, Leamington Spa

From a point 7 metres west of the junction with New Brook Street, in a westerly direction for a distance of 30 metres (which includes the revocation of existing limited waiting restrictions and L3 permit places in connection with the removal of the layby and widening of the footway).
