ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

**THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (D2204 CHANTRY HEATH LANE /
STONELEIGH ROAD, BAGINTON)
(50 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2024**

Warwickshire County Council have made the above named Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to impose a 50 mph speed limit on the length of road mentioned in the Schedule below. The Order commences on 4th November 2024.

A copy of the Order, together with a plan showing the length of road affected and a statement of the Council's reasons for making the Order, may be inspected at the Main Reception, Shire Hall, Market Place, Warwick, at the Borough / District Council, at the Public Library during usual opening hours and on the Council's website:

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order may within six weeks from the date of the making of the Order apply to the High Court for this purpose.
